This Is Your Life!

Dear Friend,

When Jesus was born his name was a common one in the East. It is the same name in Aramaic as Joshua, which means "savior." There was no family or last name used at the time; so, to distinguish one Jesus from another the name was tied to the father or to a particular town. He was known as "Jesus, son of Joseph" or "Jesus of Nazareth." His name was not "Jesus Christ"; Christ is not a last name, but a title which means "the anointed." Priests, kings, and prophets were anointed. Aaron was anointed a priest of Israel by his brother, Moses; Saul and David were anointed kings by Samuel, and Isaiah was anointed a prophet by the Lord.

In Aramaic, the word for Christ is Misheekha, which means "the anointed." This word was translated into Greek as Christos which comes from the verb chrio, meaning "to rub with oil"—the way one was anointed. It is a symbol for enlightenment. Whenever you read the word Christ, substitute enlightened and you will have a clearer understanding of the term.

The Christ is not born in the sense that something comes into being that did not exist before. The birth of the Christ is really an awakening or enlightenment that takes place within the individual soul or consciousness. It is an awakening to the divine nature expressing as the true, spiritual, higher self. God's perfect spiritual man has always been, and will always be, for it is eternal. This spiritual awareness does not come upon us; we awaken to recognize within ourselves what has been since before the foundation of the world—Christ in you the hope of glory!

Matthew said, "Jesus was born, who is called the Christ." (1:16) Bodies are born, personalities are formed, but the image-likeness of God is not born. The Christ has always been and continues to be "the true light that enlightens every man." (John 1:9)

It was not Jesus the man who healed the sick or spoke Truth or ministered to the multitudes. It was Jesus "the anointed" or enlightened who healed and spoke and ministered. The anointing has never ended. Just as Isaiah said, "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me" (Isa 61:1), so you can know that the same spirit of the Lord is upon you. You have within you the Christ just as Jesus had within him. You must look within to recognize your divine origin and birth. When this light dawns, you see yourself and life in a whole new way; not as a mere person, but as a projection of Divine Mind; not only as a physical being, but as Spirit. Jesus the Christ affirmed his true self and that self came into expression. Reveal your Self to yourself by affirming: I AM the Christ, an expression of the living God!

At this time of year, we seem to have a hunger for light from candles, Christmas trees, and decorations hanging from our homes. How fitting it is that one of the main symbols for the Christmas season is light. It reminds us that we hunger and thirst for enlightenment, to finally glimpse the powers and potentials that have been ours since the beginning. This Christmas, open wide your inner eyes and behold the Spirit of the Lord upon you.
